To *the Traveling Executive*: You have heard the stories, or might have been in one of those situations abroad— life-threatening at worst, and inconvenient at best.

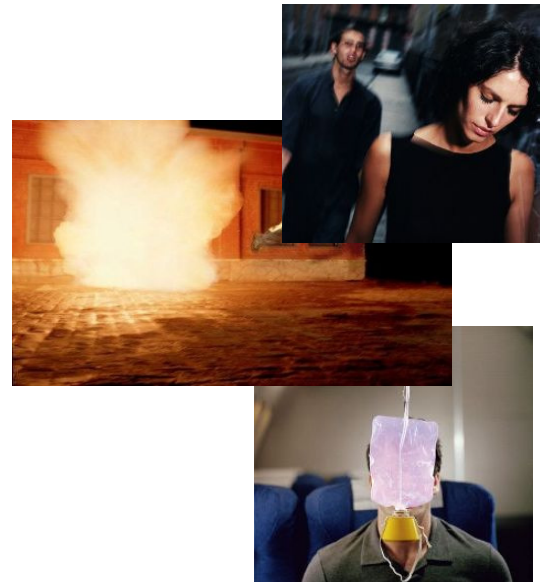
The truth is: You are at greater risk than you know.
