

WORKSHOP ON “SECURING THE INTEGRITY OF CLOSED CTU MOVEMENTS IN THE SUPPLY CHAIN”

The International Labour Organization (ILO), together with the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA) jointly organized a 2-day National Container Security Workshop over 21-22 June 2006 in ST Education & Training Pte Ltd, Singapore.

The purpose of the workshop was to update participants involving Government Agencies, Employers & Workers on international developments in the Security of CTU Supply Chain vis-à-vis Concepts, Principles of, and Measures for CTU Security.

Representatives from Singapore included those from the Government and Authority such as Ministry of Trade & Industry, Immigration & Checkpoint Authority, Maritime & Port Authority, Singapore Navy and the Police Cost Guard, Singapore, as well as those from industry players such as Jurong Port, NSSPL, SOPS and Wan Hai Lines. A representative from the SPWU was in attendance throughout the 2-Day Workshop programme.

Delegates from International Organisations such as those of WCO and OSCE, as well as those with vested interest to proliferate Supply Chain Security of Containers were in attendance to value-add to the programme – these involved among others, members from the International Association of Ports and Harbours and Container Security Initiative, US; US Coast Guard.
