

**STET MARITIME BUREAU AWARDED MPA TENDER TO PROVIDE CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE NATIONAL SUPPLY CHAIN SECURITY GUIDELINES AND PREPARATION OF AN IMPLEMENTATION PLAN**

**The National Supply Chain Security**

The Singapore inter government agency committee will be initiating a National Supply Chain Security Guidelines to ensure the integrity and security of the supply chain in Singapore. These Guidelines will be consistent with key international supply chain security requirements.

The Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA), on behalf of the inter government agency committee has appointed STET Maritime Bureau as a consultant for the Supply Chain Security Guideline project and to engage the industry to solicit feedback and critique on challenges in adopting such security measures.

STET Maritime Bureau has formed two avenues where Company can gather the necessary feedback from the industry and obtain their views.

1) Via survey questionnaires

An introduction on the Supply Chain Security Guidelines is made available online for members to read and find out more about Supply Chain Security. STET Maritime Bureau will provide necessary introduction and questionnaire for members to fill online and data will be consolidated automatically.

2) Via focus group discussion

STET Maritime Bureau has formed a focus group session for member committee or its nominated members. During the focus group sessions, a presentation on the Supply Chain Guidelines are given, its component discussed and members can give feedback and share their experiences.

The first focus group discussion was successfully conducted on 14<sup>th</sup> July with 20 members' participation. Positive interaction was observed during the discussion and members actively shared their views and concerns.
