

ISPS INTERMEDIATE VERIFICATION

INTERMEDIATE VERIFICATION PROCEDURE FOR ISPS COMPLIANT PORT FACILITIES

Reference: MPA - PT/PM/4.004/8(a) CF dated 29 Jun 2006

All Port Facilities who have been issued with a Statement of Compliance in respect of a port facility shall undergo an intermediate verification exercise conducted by a Recognized Security Organization (RSO) to determine whether, as at the date of the intermediate verification exercise, the port facility complies with:

- (a) the requirements of the ISPS code that are relevant to the port facility; and
- (b) such additional requirements as Maritime Port Authority may impose.
